

## **Partial results to Communal Evaluation of CLC Central Region's**

### **Common Apostolic Mission (CAM) for People of Haiti**

**May 2013**

Surveys to evaluate the success of the Common Apostolic Mission for the people of Haiti initiated in 2010 were sent to all communities in Central Region in Winter 2013 (both as a pdf document and as a link to an online survey). Communities were asked to review and prayerfully consider their responses to the questions, before sending a combined response. Nine communities responded providing an approximately 30% response rate. A summary of numerical responses are provided below. Full survey responses showing all responses including comments and more detailed answers are provided in a separate document.

- Agreement that Central Region's Common Apostolic Mission for the People of Haiti has contributed to some transformation in the following areas:
  - Cohesiveness of CLC Central Region – 100%
  - Life for Haitians - 87.5%
  - Spirituality of members – 87.5%
  - Our understanding and solidarity with poor Haitians – 75%
  - Relationships w others (e.g. CVX, Jesuits etc.) – 75%
  
- Satisfaction with communications and contributions:
  - Communications about region's activities – 7.5/10
  - Communications about how they individually or as a community could contribute – 6.6/10
  - Their community's contribution to CAM – 7.1/10
  - Contribution of communities across Canada– 3.5/10
  
- How communities who responded to the survey, contributed to the Common Apostolic Mission:
  - Through finances – 87.5%
  - Through spiritual solidarity – in individual and communal prayer - 100% and 87.5%
  - Through communications and outreach - 100 and 87.5%
  
- Overall satisfaction with the activities completed by CLC Central Region to-date - 8.1/10
  
- Response to specific resources that exist within CLC Central Region
  - People who speak French – 3
  - People who speak Spanish – 2
  - Connections with those living in Haiti/DR – 1
  - Connections with those living in Haiti/DR – 2
